Biography

Sir Arthur Conan Doyle (Edinburgh, 1859) studied medicine at the University of Edinburgh. After undergoing a religious crisis and various family problems, he began writing while practicing medicine. It is at this point when he created the characters of Sherlock Holmes and Dr. Watson, both eventually becoming literary legends.

In addition to the well known Sherlock Holmes stories, Conan Doyle wrote *The Lost World* (later made into a TV series and movie of the same name), *The Great Boer War,* as well as works of other genres. His autobiography, *Memories and Adventures*, marks the culmination of his literary work. Despite his success, he never received a literary award during his writing career.


