
BRIEF HISTORY of the... NATIVE AMERICANS

SINOPSIS:

When the European colonizers arrived in North America, there were already some tribes of strange and prehistoric customs with Asian ancestors living there. It is estimated that, at the beginning of the 18th Century, the indigenous population living between the territories of North America and the north of the Rio Grande numbered approximately one million. Their conflict with the foreign invaders would give rise to one of the bloodiest and darkest periods in the history of humankind.

The first contacts between the Indians and the colonizers were pacific and, in large part, of a commercial nature. Conflicts were usually resolved through signed treaties. In 1540, the first wars began when the Spanish led by Vazquez de Coronado battled the Zuni tribe. It was not until 1890, when the US Cavalry massacred the Sioux tribe led by Big Foot at Wounded Knee that these wars ended and thereby closed 3 centuries of constant armed battle between the "pale faces" and the "redskins".
