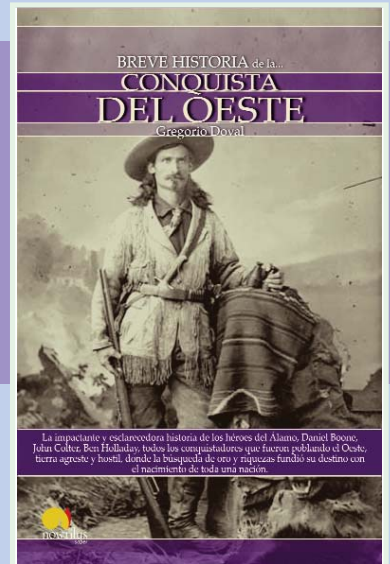


BRIEF HISTORY OF THE... CONQUEST OF THE WEST
