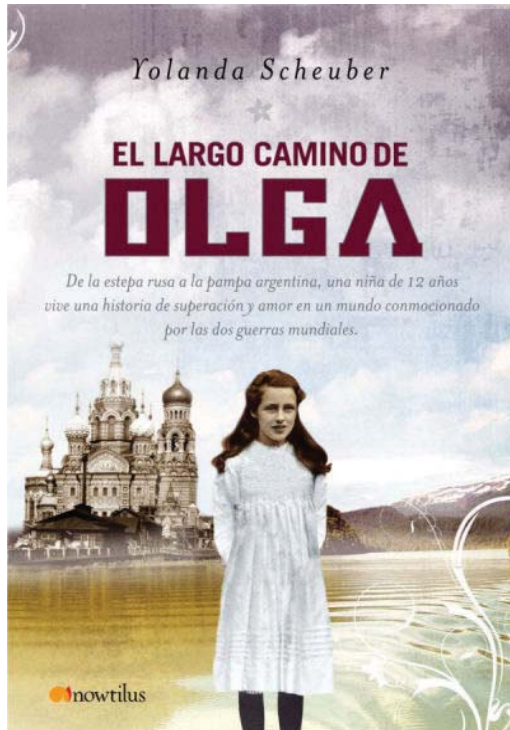

In Argentina Olga begins a new life and overcomes a lot of obstacles. She has to face new break-ups, bad news and two world wars that affect her deeply. In spite of that, she will also find love, start her own family, find people she thought had disappeared and work in her own land in the Argentine Pampa.
