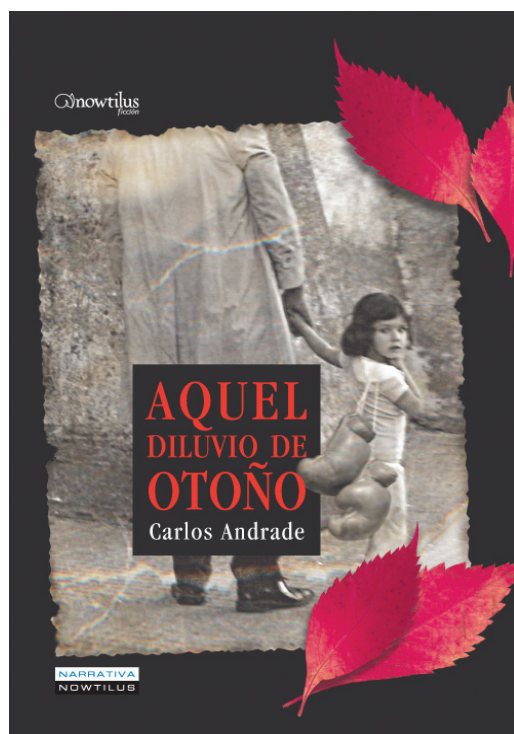

# THAT FALL'S RAINFALL

*This novel deals with the extremely difficult childhood in rural Galicia. The author creates a microcosm, Nublos, to describe Lagoa family's decline: orphan children, the losses of life that caused this family to constaty see a coffin arrive and be picked up later.*

The main character of this novel is Orestes Lagoa, a child who lives in Nublos ?a fictional small village in Galicia, in the north of Spain? with the company of his inseparable old dictionary while he sees the mainstays of his family lineage vanish. «Family emblems, coats of arms, all that useless collection of objects... what was it good for?», he wondered while he waited for the coffin to be picked up. In parallel with this, and as a counterpoint to this surprising novel, we meet boxer Bruno Broa. He is a sensitive, sentimental man, who sees the world through the Iberian pessimists' poetry and, at the same time, he hopes to succeed in Madison Square Garden in New York. In That Fall Deluge, the author skillfully alternates the different narrators' voices: the voices at Che's Inn will introduce you to a series of wonderful secondary characters. Manuel, the professor; Angustias, little Orestes's protective and inflexible sister; Azucena, daughter to a wicked priest; Alfonso Mendes, the bully; Benedicto, a mediocre boxer who is as good as gold; Milagros, Orestes's eternally ill mother; and Chuco Lagoa, Orestes's father, who is devastated by the idea that his life is nothing but the sad end of a Galician family lineage that has lost rank in the world.

## The author



**Carlos Andrade Caamaño** is a fighter by nature. He was born on May 23rd, 1957 in a small village called Artes (Municipality of Carballo), La Coruña. His childhood was marked by his mother's death, after a long illness. The harsh conditions of those times forced him to work since he was a child, which never stopped him from devouring every book that fell into his hands. He became an industrial radiologist but, in 1973, he had an accident while working with nuclear energy, which made it impossible for him to continue practicing his profession, and he turned to advertising communication. No doubt books helped him overcome this critical period. Nowadays, he is the president of an important advertising agency, Andrade & Asociados. That Fall's rain-fall is his first published novel.
