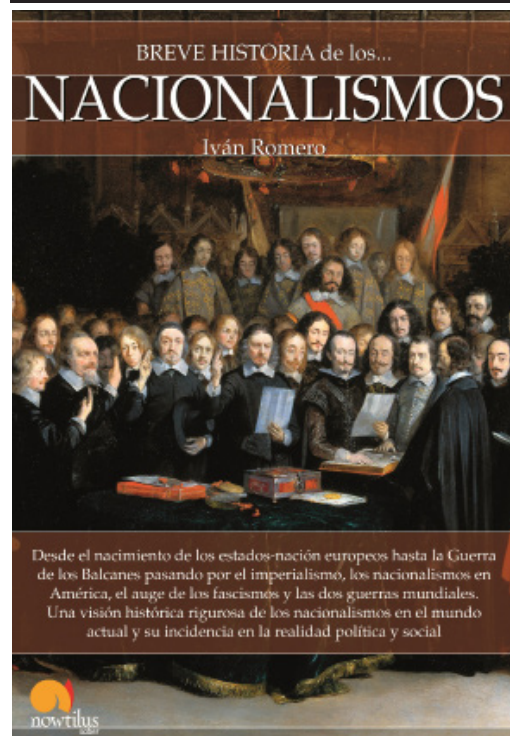
Since the beginning of the 19th century Nationalism has been one of the main protagonists of political evolution on a global scale.

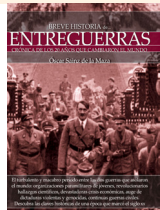

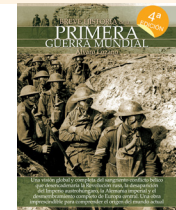
