

Biography

Víctor San Juan (Madrid, 1963) is an engineer, writer and navigator. He has previously published essays such as *Trafalgar, tres armadas en combate* (2005). As well as *The Naval Battle of the Dunes,* which was written for the bicentennial of this event and for which he was awarded the San Telmo Medal form Fundación Letras de La Mar in 2006. La Holanda Comercial contra la España del Siglo de Oro is recognized with prestige, and La Marina de los Austrias is also considered worthy of worship. He has won the Nostromo Prize of nautical literature twice. His latest novel was published in Nowtilus is *El Perfil del Infinito*. He also writes articles on nautical topics for specialized publications such as the General Magazine of Marina.
