Learn about science fiction, an unknown genre that, despite being considered by many as secondary, it has reappeared in recent years creating a new crowd of followers, creators, literary works, cinematographic sagas, TV series, comics and video games.

Brief history of Science Fiction will guide the reader through a thorough tour of this genre, begining with its distant background by the Sumerian Gilgamesh, the Christian Bible or the Egyptian Book of the Dead, through to its forefathers Julio Verne and H. G. Wells, the real parents of a different way of writting. The path of the book lead the reader through the genre's transformation into an American phenomenon of the 20th century, allegedly invented by Hugo Gernsback, with the appearance of magazines such as Astounding Stories, laws of Robotics in Asimov, the emergence of great films that marked a turning point as The Andromeda Strain, Close Encounters of the Third Kind, or Star Wars, the experimentation and new subgenres as cyberpunk, or steampunk, as well as the philosophical Sci-Fi, psychological, feminism or the dystopias.

Luis E. Íñigo Fernández will guide the reader in the discovery of this cultural trend through film and literature reflecting on the human condition, and his destiny in the distant future. The author will show the reader a reflection of the historical context of the time, and give the reader some recommendations of the best examples that will help with the immersion in this genre and provide deep knowledge.

Luis Íñigo Fernández was born in Guadalajara in 1966. He holds a Master's Degree and a PhD in History, he has been a Secondary School teacher for sixteen years, and currently is a educational inspector, and a University Professor. He has developed a long career as a fiction author, researcher and populariser. His works include numerous articles on the second Spanish Republic, as well as the books Melquíades Álvarez: a liberal in the Second Spanish Republic (2000), The liberal right wing in the Second Spanish Republic (2000), Spain. History of an Unfinished Nation (2005), Plain and Simple Western History (2008), and the monographs Brief History of Spain, I and II, Brief History of Alchemy, Brief History of the second Spanish Republic, Brief History of the World, Brief History of the Industrial Revolution, Brief History of the Battle of Trafalgar, and Brief History of the battle of Lepanto, published in this same collection, as well as The Questioned Spain and Universal History in 100 questions, also published by Nowtilus.
