# A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE CROWN OF ARAGON

#### Synopsis

With this work the reader will discover how the dynastic union of the Kings of Aragon with the Counts of Barcelona allowed the expansion of the Catalonian-Aragonese domains, via force of arms, beyond the Iberian Peninsula becoming one of the most powerful maritime Empires with possessions in the Mediterranean.

Firstly, the work discovers the antecedents of the Crown of Aragon with the creation of the Marca Hispánica by the Frankish Emperor Carlomagno and his son Louis I the Pious, and the County of Aragon dynastic links with the Kings of Pamplona. The surprising decision of the Aragonese King Alfonso I the Battler of leaving all his possessions to the military orders pushed the dissatisfied Aragonese nobility to take the initiative, and support the union with the lineage of the Counts of Barcelona.

The author analyzes in detail the first years of the new Catalonian-Aragonese dynasty, which had to agree with their neighbour Kingdom of Castile, the peninsular southward expansion to the detriment of the Muslim expansion of the Al-Andalus. Also their confrontation with the papacy, and with the French monarch, to defend his vassals during the conflict of the Cathars in the sound of France.

David González Ruiz (Barcelona, 1976) holds a Master's degree in History, specialized in Medieval History by the University of Barcelona, and a Master's degree in Documentation by the Autonomous University of Barcelona. He currently works as Senior Technician of Files in the Historical Archive of Sabadell, teaches History of Catalonia in the Catalan universities. 
