Synopsis

This book is an entertaining approach to what the people of the Golden Age thought about the natural and the supernatural, concepts that nowadays do not match those of the current men and women. In its pages the boundaries between the possible and the impossible, the life and the hereafter are erased. The imagination can transform or build reality, hybrid beings are born product of copulation of human beings with animals, with devils or mythical beings such as sirens or the water women.

Visiting the book's pages the reader, admired, will realise how some phenomena are perfectly described by the historians and the great writers of the most sublime era of the Spanish Literature. These phenomena occupy nowadays the mass media: sightings of strange lights, abductions, night visitors, poltergeists, haunted houses, raining animals or strange objects, plagues of rodents that suddenly appear and disappear, or the power of therapeutic music.

Biography

Luciano López Gutiérrez holds a PhD in Spanish Philology by the Universidad Complutense of Madrid with a thesis on the Satirical and Burlesque Poetry of the Golden Age. He has published several editions of classics. Great *connoisseur* of the 16th and 17th centuries, he is the author of articles on the Literature of this period that have appeared in the *Boletín de la Real Academia Española*, *Dicenda*, *CSIC's Literary Journal* or *La Perinola*. The author is a High School Teacher, currently Head of Department and teaches Spanish Language and Literature at the Instituto Iturralde of Madrid.



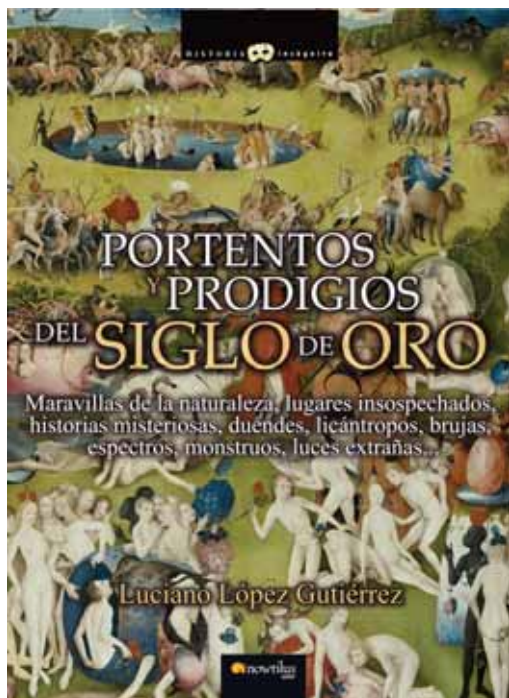
