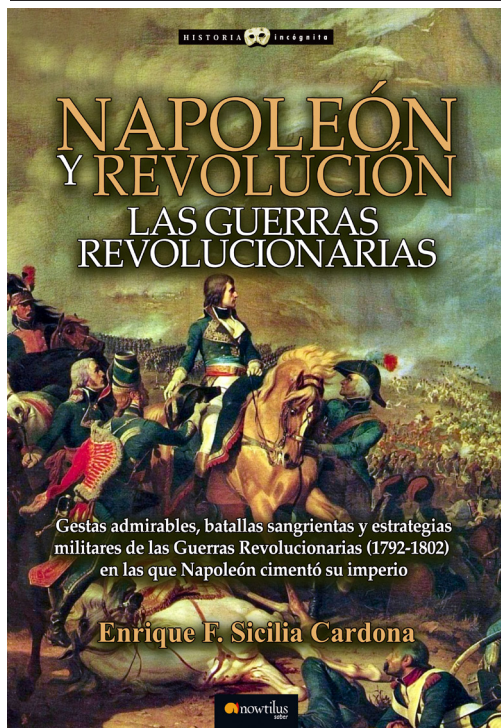


# NAPOLEON AND REVOLUTION THE REVOLUTIONARY WARS

The French had the support of a more experienced army, leaders such as Napoleon or Moreau, and an excessive victory attitude with the hope they could establish their new republic. Would they finally win the battle or would they be defeated by their unstoppable enemies?

*Napoleón and Revolution* will get you closer to the ten years in which the French revolutionary tried to expand their basis for the acceptance of democracy and constitutional order around the continent.

Its author, Enrique F. Sicilia Cardona, makes an exhaustive analysis of the campaigns and decisive battles such as Valmy. Naval and land action, bloody battles, conquer expeditions, enemy landings, legendary military figures, and new tactics and strategies. A tumultuous European period that was developed together with the brightness of the French Revolution and that anticipated the subsequent Napoleonic empire.

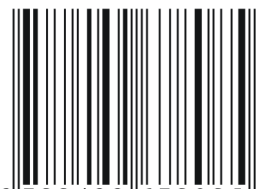
