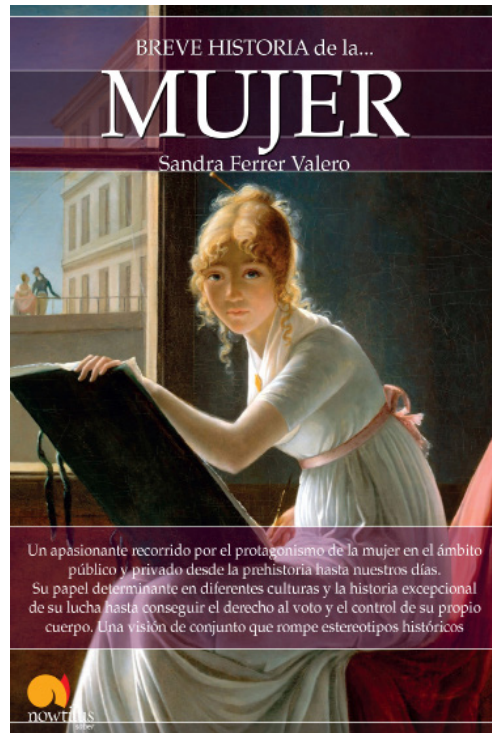
Biography

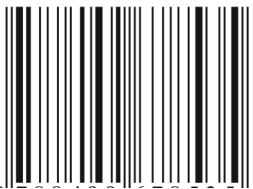

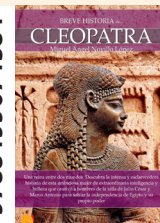
