

Emperors and laws, popes and ceremonies, peasants and traditions, nativity scenes ands and fir trees, wizards and carols, have a place in this work that offers a complete, and chronological overview of the Christmas festivities. An entertaining, and rigorous book that will allow the reader to know the history, from the first century to the present day, of one of the fundamental factors of our culture.

In Nowtilus Editions he has published Gods, Temples and Oracles and Brief History of Jesus of Nazareth. He is professor of History of Ancient Religions at the Biblical and Oriental Institute of León, a job that reconciles with teaching in secondary school.
